#### Introduction

Welcome to the 2025 Weymouth Sailing Club SB20 UK and Open National Championship. Weymouth Sailing Club is delighted to have the opportunity to host this event, and are looking forward to an enjoyable weekend of sailing and socialising as part of the regatta.

Below you will find some information about what to expect when arriving in Weymouth, and what's on during the event.

#### **Arrivals**

Competitors will be welcome to the club from Wednesday 8th July from 0900. If you are planning to arrive earlier in the week, then please let us know and I will arrange access to the main yard (provide you with the key code).

Please contact our yard representative and co-ordinator Mike Jones on 07599 846040 15 minutes before you plan to arrive at the un-hitch location, which is shown on the map below (turn left at the Old Rooms Inn prior to Nothe Parade). It would also be helpful if you can let Mike know approximately when you plan to arrive. This will enable any potential conflicts to be resolved.

You will be met by a club member at the un-hitch location. From here we will assist you in pulling your SB20 along the quay to the club yard. This is to prevent traffic jams as turning space can be limited in the club yard. Car access to the yard is limited, although can be arranged through Mike for an unloading period only, if this is required.

We ask that you unload everything you need as quickly as possible and then park your car in one of the Nothe Fort car parks, or if you are lucky, you may find a free space on Barracks Road on the way to the car park. This is a two-minute drive from the club, and an even shorter walk back to the club down the steps at the end of the small car park opposite the blue food kiosk.



## Launching

The schedule for cranage into the harbour will then be arranged in sequence (roughly according to the order of arrival in the yard). This plan will be detailed and co-ordinated once masts are stepped and competitors are ready. Preference will be to launch in good time piror to racing.

#### Club House Rules.

- 1. Only alcoholic drinks purchased at the club can be consumed upstairs in the main club house.
- 2. No wet kit upstairs in the main club house.
- 3. Outside there are no rules, but please be respectful

# Registration.

Registration will take place at WSC on Wednesday 9th July between 10:30 and 18:30 and Thursday 10th July between 08:00 and 12:00.

#### Official Notice Board.


The official notice board will be located in the club foyer. A copy of the NOR's, Si's and any notice of change will be displayed here.

#### Pebble Bank

Small local run camping, touring and static caravan site. Pebble Bank is roughly a 10 to 15-minute cycle from the club, or a short drive/taxi ride. Alternatively, it's around a 10-minute walk to Portland road where there is a regular number 1 bus service to Weymouth, which operates a 24-hour service on a Friday and Saturday night. Possibly the closest site to the club.

# Weymouth Camping and Caravan Park

Not far from Pebble Bank. Roughly a 15 minutes mainly flat cycle ride from the club along the Rodwell trail. Closer to Portland road for the number 1 bus service.

#### Highermoor farm

A camping and touring site just outside of Weymouth with pods to hire. Small farm shop on site. However, you will need a car or taxi to get to and from here. No local bus passes this site.

# Seabarn Farm

Larger camping and touring site with small shop. Roughly around a 20-30 minute cycle from the club. Alternatively, you could catch the number 8 bus which runs every 30 minutes until 1930. Failing that is a short drive or taxi to the club.

The biggest of the 3 Haven sites in Weymouth is Littlesea. This has camping, touring and static caravans available. Around a 15-20 minutes' cycle, 10-minute walk to the closest number 8 bus stop or a short car/taxi ride. Ideal if you're bringing the family.

# Weymouth Bay



Not much smaller than Littlesea, Weymouth bay is a flattish, 15-20 minute cycle from the club, or the Number 4 bus which stops right outside and runs until 2330.



# Free on Road Parking



You could get lucky and find a space on Barracks Road by Cefas for the whole of the event. This is located behind the club, and there are steps which lead almost directly in the club yard. The best free option for parking is along Netherton Rd, Bincleaves Rd or Belle Vue Rd. These are quiet residential roads where the houses are set back from the road and you can park all day for free. It is where most club members park when sailing all day as it is an easy 10 minutes walk to the club.
